All sessions of the Workshop (9am–6pm, Saturday, October 27th, 9am–1pm, Sunday, October 28th) will be held in DeBartolo Hall, room 129. DeBartolo Hall is the large building directly west of the football stadium (campus map). Entry to it on both Saturday and Sunday will be through the doors on the north end. There will be a shuttle service available between the hotel and Debartolo Hall.

In addition to the shuttle between the lodge and Debartolo, the lodge operates a shuttle to and from South Bend Regional Airport (aka Michiana Regional Airport). Please contact the lodge directly for further information and reservations for the shuttle service. Train service, bus service and car rental are also available at the airport.

As usual, there will be a limited number of room vouchers available to students attending the workshop to help defray the cost of their attending.
