This month's 'Philosopher in Print' is HPS Grad Student, Sebastian Murgueitio Ramirez. His textbook for first semester undergraduate students titled "Física paso a paso" is available for purchase on Amazon!



Summary:

Física Paso a Paso is a textbook (in Spanish) published by Ediciones Uniandes that aims to help students going from high school to college improve their foundations in physics before moving into more advanced courses. It accomplishes this task by providing step by step solutions to over a hundred problems and utilizing considerably more illustrations than other textbooks on the market today. The topics covered are vectors, kinematics, projectiles, forces, and energy. Besides the fact that there are no other comparable Spanish physics textbooks that solve problems at the level of detail found in this publication, the book is also innovative in that it incorporates elements of Latin American life through references to sporting figures and Colombian popular culture.
